- Double space all lines.
- Indent the second line and those lines following five spaces or one tab.
- If no author is given, start with the title.
- Abbreviate the names of all months except May, June, and July.
- If the encyclopedia does not arrange its articles alphabetically, treat the encyclopedia article as if it were a book article.
- Use only the name of the city. Do not include the state.
- With subscription databases, including the URL is acceptable, but optional.
